



## Part-Time Games/PE & Outdoor Pursuits Teacher

Experience of and knowledge in Steiner Waldorf approach desirable.

### Requirements:

1. Extensive knowledge in Games/PE, Team sports and outdoor pursuits.
2. Experience of teaching games to children aged 9-18.
3. Working hours required: Six 45min sessions weekly, with seasonal changes.
4. Outdoor pursuits support of 5 sessions, depending on experience.
5. Involvement in school trips.
6. Understanding of and commitment to all Safeguarding policies and procedures.
7. Ability to adapt to different age groups and different styles of learning.
8. Understanding and ability to work with different abilities.
9. Ability to be creative in the delivery of the subject.
10. Knowledge and experience of Steiner Waldorf approach desirable.
11. Organised and able to work on their own, taking initiatives, as well as being part of a team.
12. Able to communicate closely with class teachers and faculty in general.
13. Comfortable with a highly collaborative workplace.
14. Attendance at weekly meetings preferable, outside working hours.
15. Enthusiasm and sense of humour desirable.

The candidate should have strong classroom management skills and an ability to bring structure in a joyful environment. The candidate may be asked to attend certain events in the school community, such as Open Days and Festivals. Attendance at parents' evenings, in-service days and CPD is on a pro-rata basis.
